Treasurer's Report: \$161.16 (total for three checks) is due to Agnes Oakley (winnings from a raffle) and Dean Salley, due to checks issued to them in the past that were not cashed. Dean made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, seconded by Marilyn Featherston. Carried

Bob McArthur: First complemented OCHS on the Murder Mystery night. Bob McArthur, along with Mary Kassuba and electrician, Gary Stewart have made a preliminary assessment of the electrical and lighting issues within the Old Mill Museum.

Their committee noticed:

- issues with extension cords (safety issue as people are not in the Old Mill at all times),
- the need for more electrical outlets,
- · need for double the number of and better light fixtures,
- issues with wiring not for the uses but we made them do
- issue with at least one "Hot Wire" uncapped.
- · Other issues were need for an EXIT sign in the apartment on second floor,
- Need for more exit doors (might be able to use the door in the Main Mill Room if reworked it),
- Need for motion lights on the rear porch,
- · Need for rewiring a chandelier,
- lights needed on the 3rd floor
- · Lights needed in both stairways.

We will ask Gary Stewart for a rough idea on the cost.

Dean Salley made a motion to move on the lighting repair project, not to exceed \$2000. There was discussion. Maryllyn Featherston seconded this motion. It died, only 2 voted for this motion.

Bob said he could have a more concrete estimate to start repairs and then could add extras later. Discussion ensued about using the Hamilton \$2000 donation for this issue. We need light outside of the Old Mill. Bob will come back with more information.

A motion was made by Mary Alice and seconded by Ken Bush to have Mr. Stewart proceed with the wish list for the electrical. Carried. Bob Will give us an update next month.

Committee consists of: Mary Alice Seelbinder, Marie Kuehl, Mary Kassuba, Trina Lang.

Maple Lane Kennel has offered an 1850 year old barn to the OCHS. Dismantle and remove from property. Dean will investigate tomorrow and report at next meeting.

Newsletter: Committee now consists of: Judy Miracle - typist and mailing labels, Ken Bush - historical stories, Mary Kassuba - printing, Marilyn Feathrston - folding, addressing and mailing.
